- a man sentenced to life imprisonment, to serve a minimum of 20 years, with calls for his execution on the website of a tabloid newspaper;
- an Algerian national in his 60s, never previously in prison, awaiting sentence for being a “drugs mule”;
- a mother of young children, serving life;
- a prisoner transferred to mental hospital, with little prospect of release into the community;
- a life prisoner in the sixth year of his sentence;
- a homeless self-harmer, imprisoned indefinitely.
